2		Please explain in detail why, if domestic customers in coastal Labrador and
3		residential customers in the L'Anse au Loup System both pay the equivalent
4		electricity rates as Labrador Interconnected Customers for their basic electricity
5		needs, the average rate increase will be 20.4% for the former, and 4.5% for the
6		latter.
7		
8		
9	A.	Residential customers in coastal Labrador and L'Anse au Loup receive a government
10		rebate that reduces their rates for the Basic Customer Charge and Lifeline Block of
11		kWhs, to equal those of Labrador Interconnected residential customers. Over and
12		above these amounts, both systems have differing sets of rates which are charged.
