The deferred 15% rate increase subsidy and the Northern Strategic Plan (NSP) 9 subsidy are independent of one another, although both are provided by the 10 Provincial Government. The NSP applies only to the domestic lifeline block and 11 basic customer charge, and the 15% deferred rate increase applies to rates other 12 than those to which the NSP applies. The 15% rate increase was approved in 2007, 13 and has been deferred since that time. The rates for non-Government rate classes 14 in the isolated system are based upon Newfoundland Power (NP) rates and these rates are only available after NP has completed its rate design. 15 16 17 For a detailed rate change explanation, please see PUB-NLH-107.
