3		All tolls, rates and charges shall always, under substantially

7		what shall constitute substantially similar circumstances and
8		<u>conditions</u> .
9		Has the Board declared by regulation what shall constitute substantially similar
10		circumstances and conditions? If so, please provide references.

13	A.	To Hydro's knowledge, the Board has not declared by regulation what constitutes
14		substantially similar circumstances and conditions, however, the Board has
15		approved different costs of service for different electrical systems or groups of
16		systems. Hydro has two interconnected systems each with their own cost
17		structures and rates (the Labrador Interconnected System and the Island
18		Interconnected System) and provides electrical service in its Rural Isolated Systems
19		which are treated as three systems for costing purposes (Labrador Rural Isolated,
20		Island Rural Isolated and L'Anse au Loup).
