

1 Q. **Natuashish**

2 **Re: IN-NLH-098, IN-NLH-205**

3 In IN-NLH-205, Hydro stated:

4 Hydro prefers to enter into a formal agreement to clarify its contractual
5 rights and obligations with MIFN as to operating the Natuashish electrical
6 system.

7 Does Hydro have any formal agreement with Sheshiatshiu Innu First Nation, or the
8 Federal government, with respect to the operation of the electrical system in
9 Sheshiatshiu? If not, is Hydro engaged in negotiations for reaching such an
10 agreement? If not, does Hydro seek to enter into such an agreement?

13 A. Hydro provides service to its customers in Sheshiatshiu from a distribution system
14 on its Labrador Interconnected System. Hydro has no formal agreement with
15 respect to operations issues pertaining to this electrical distribution system with
16 which Hydro provides service to its customers in Sheshiatshiu. There are, however,
17 parcels of land that were excluded or enclaved from the Sheshiatshiu Innu First
18 Nation lands for the purpose of containing Hydro's transmission and distribution
19 plant required to serve customers in that community.
