1	Q.	If there are new mining developments in Labrador and if their construction or
2		operation uses the Labrador Interconnected System then will all the incremental
3		capital cost to the system be paid by these new users? What will NL Hydro's policies
4		be in this regard?
5		
6		
7	A.	Please see Hydro's response to LWHN-NLH-007 which contains a Government of
8		Newfoundland and Labrador News Release and Backgrounder. The Backgrounder
9		contains this passage:
10		
11		In addition to charges for generation, industrial customers will pay an additional
12		amount based on the costs of required transmission. Under the recommended
13		policy, transmission service and rates would be fully regulated by the PUB
14		beginning in 2015 based on the cost of service principles currently in use on the
15		Island. Transmission owners would be entitled to recover costs and collect a rate
16		of return on their assets in Labrador.
