5		"The Board is also concerned with the fairness to the individual customers of NP
6		who will have this cost passed through to them once the amount is assigned to NP.
7		We do not share the opinion that the allocation of the deficit has little effect on the
8		individual customers of NP. The customers of NP on relative terms are very
9		sensitive to changes in rates."
10		
11		Please confirm that in the very next sentence the Board states:
12		
13		"This of course is equally true of Labrador Interconnected Customers and
14		Industrial Customers."
