Please discuss advantages and disadvantages of the existing Rural Deficit allocation methodology as compared to the allocation of the Rural Deficit based on i) annual revenue requirement (before Rural Deficit allocation) and ii) the number of customers in each system (i.e., as illustrated in Table 4.3 on page 4.10 of the Evidence to the Amended Application).

A. Under the existing allocation, Labrador customers would pay \$653.15 compared to NP \$216.64. An allocation based on revenue requirement would result in Labrador customers paying \$207.60 and NP customers paying \$236.46. On a per customer basis both groups of customers would pay \$235.23 per customer. Either a revenue or per customer allocation would appear to be more equitable than the existing allocation.
