5	Q.	Does Dr. Feehan believe that allocation of the rural deficit must necessarily be somewhat
6		arbitrary? Please explain.
7		
8	A.	As long as provincial policy requires Labrador Interconnected and NP customers to bear the
9		burden of the rural deficit, I think that the criteria for the allocation of that deficit should be
10		characterized as follows.
11		1. The allocation method should be understandable to customers;
12		2. the amount paid by customers towards the rural deficit should be made explicit on their bills;
13		3. the burden should be allocated fairly; and
14		4. distortions of energy rates should be minimized.
15		
16		I agree that judgment within these characteristics is called for in order to set an operational
17		method of allocation.
