1	Q.	in the response to Request for Information NP-NLH-357, Hydro states:
2		"Rates charged to customers in 2014, and now potentially 2015, will not accurately
3		reflect the costs associated with the service provided in that period. This places an
4		increased burden on future customers to fund recovery of costs incurred in previous
5		years estimated at \$113.7 million".
6		Given that it is unlikely that final rates will be in place in 2015, please comment on
7		the degree to which Hydro considered the gap between costs and customer rates in
8		its 2 <sup>nd</sup> quarter 2014 decision-making to amend its GRA.
