

1 Q. In the response to Request for Information CA-NLH-328, Hydro states:
2 *"The 2015 Test Year includes...a challenging reduction in overtime expenses from*
3 *historic levels."*

4 Please indicate the amount of overtime expenses that were incurred as a result of
5 the January 2013 and January 2014 outages and any follow up maintenance or
6 repair work that resulted.

9 A. The January 2013 outage resulted in approximately \$0.2 million in overtime. In the
10 2014 and 2015 Test Years, the January 2014 outage resulted in approximately \$0.3
11 million in overtime. Please refer to Hydro's response to V-NLH-088 for the
12 breakdown of the total incremental costs related to the 2014 outage.
