4		meetings with the industrial customers to explore the possibility of interruptible
5		power contracts need to happen immediately."
6		Is it Mr. Dean's opinion that it is also important that the matter of the treatment of
7		Newfoundland Power's curtailable load be resolved expeditiously?
8		
9		
10	Α.	It is my opinion that Hydro should immediately pursue all meaningful sources of
11		interruptible/curtailable load that can be used by used to reduce the Island
12		Interconnected system peak when required by Hydro. The interruptible/curtailable
13		rate should be treated in the same manner for both NP and industrial customers and
14		should be available to all customers that meet certain Board approved guidelines.
15		The guidelines would include items such as minimum interruptible load, notice
16		required, length and frequency of interruption and annual maximum interruptible
17		hours.
