A.	If the current arrangements are terminated and Hydro's proposal to stabilize the
	power purchases energy supply variations is approved, customers would be
	charged, through the RSP, for the fuel required to supply the load which would no
	longer be served from the Exploits Generation Power Purchases.
	If there is a change in the purchase price and Hydro's proposal to stabilize the
	power purchases energy supply variations is approved, customers would be
	charged for the increase or credited with the decrease through the RSP.
	If Hydro's proposal to stabilize energy supply costs is not approved, Hydro's net
	income would see the impact of the increase in fuel costs if the arrangement was
	terminated or if the power purchase cost varied from the Test Year costs.
