1	Q.	2013 General Rate Application, Operating Expenses
2		Have the benefits provided through Hydro's group insurance benefits been
3		enhanced or improved since 2007? If yes, provide details of the changes.
4		
5		
6	A.	Hydro provides a group insurance benefit program as part of a total compensation
7		package that is competitive with industry and other Atlantic Canadian electric
8		utilities. Since 2007, there have been minor enhancements to Hydro's group
9		insurance benefits as follows:
10		
11		Supplementary Health
12		a. Extended Health Benefits:
13		i. The maximum for mastectomy brassieres was revised from one in any
14		eighteen (18)-month period to two in a calendar year;
15		ii. Special Ambulance Attendant was included to a maximum benefit of
16		\$500 in a calendar year; and
17		iii. Other Practitioners was revised to include speech therapist with a
18		maximum benefit of \$250 per calendar year.
19		b. Vision Care:
20		i. The Vision Care benefit was revised to include laser corrective eye
21		surgery every ten consecutive calendar years in combination with lenses
22		frames, and contact lenses to a maximum of \$1,000 for employees and
23		spouse and \$2,000 for dependent children.

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1	Life Insurance
2	Life Insurance coverage was revised to extend full coverage for active
3	employees up to age 70; and the paid-up life insurance was increased from
4	\$5,000 to \$10,000 for retirees aged 65 years or beyond.
5	
6	Long-Term Disability
7	a. Non-evidence amount increased: The non-evidence monthly maximum for
8	Long-Term Disability was increased from \$6,000 to \$9,000.
9	b. Enhanced contribution amount: Employee contributions to the Public
10	Service Pension Plan while on Long-Term Disability increased from 6% to 8%
