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1	Q.	Further to response to IN-NLH-106, provide a full description of precisely what is
2		meant in each instance where it is indicated that the rate is "Indexed based on NP's
3		average rate change to this rate class". Also, provide examples of how these rates
4		are set.

7	A.	"Indexed based on NP's average rate change to this rate class" means that once
8		Newfoundland Power has redesigned its rates and produced percentage increases
9		for its customer classes, Hydro applies these same increases for its respective
10		isolated system classes. This is in accordance with Section 16 of Hydro's Rules and
11		Regulations.
12		
13		Please see PUB-NLH-349 Attachment 1 (Schedule B from Hydro's filing for rates
14		effective July 1, 2013), for the calculation of indexed rates resulting from
15		Newfoundland Power's most recent rate changes.
