

1 Q. The response to PUB-NLH-403 states: *“As illustrated in Table 4.14 of the Evidence to*
2 *Hydro’s Amended Application, 63.37% of the total Transmission Demand Costs will*
3 *be recovered through Labrador Industrial Customers through the Labrador Industrial*
4 *Transmission Rate of \$1.25/kW effective January 1, 2015.”* Please explain if there
5 are other charges to IOCC Firm beside the allocated 63.37% Transmission Demand
6 rate mentioned above. In other words, how is the remaining \$1,387,462 allocated
7 cost to IOCC Firm (as shown on Schedule 3.2E, page 3 of 4, of the COS, Updated
8 Exhibit 13) recovered?

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11 A. The remaining \$1,387,462 allocated cost to Labrador Industrial Customers will be
12 recovered through the non-regulated Labrador Industrial Generation Demand rate
13 of \$0.43/kW, effective January 1, 2015.
