What is not included in the space rental costs amounts, and why are these costs not allocated to Nalcor? Why are the Hydro Place 5 Emergency Diesel Power System expenses significantly higher in 2014 in 6 comparison to the other years?

Hydro confirms that the residual amount of the expenses associated with Hydro Place Emergency Diesel Power System expenses not included in the Admin fee are borne by Hydro. The unallocated costs relate to maintenance costs on a transfer switch that were not grouped with the other costs associated with the Hydro Place Emergency Diesel Power System. Beginning in mid 2014, these costs are now included in the Admin fee. Please see the updated table for 2014 actuals and allocation. Costs in 2014 were higher due to: (i) additional corrective and preventative maintenance conducted on the emergency diesel power system and (ii) the cost of fuel.
