Does Mr. D. Bowman acknowledge that in the August 2013 RSP report, that an amount of \$160, 749, 555 was removed from the load variation of the IC RSP and also that an amount of \$112, 573, 325 was allocated to the NP RSP?

A. Mr. Doug Bowman acknowledges that Hydro's response to IR-V-NLH-006 indicates that in the August 2013 RSP report, an amount of \$160,749,555 was removed from the load variation of the IC RSP and an amount of \$112,573,325 was allocated to the NP RSP. These transfers took place in response to Board Order No. P.U. 26(2013) which ordered (page 3): "Hydro shall on August 31, 2013: i) credit \$49 million to the Island Industrial customers' Rate Stabilization Plan; and ii) transfer the remaining balance in the January 1, 2007 to August 31, 2013 accumulated Load Variation component of the Rate Stabilization Plan to the credit of the Newfoundland Power Inc. Rate Stabilization Plan." This Order was in response to OC2013-089, as amended (see page 1, lines 17 to 26).
