

1 Q. (Re: Response to CA-NLH-70) The response states "Hydro is proposing that the
2 parties discuss options for treatment of NP curtailable load that address Hydro's
3 concerns" (listed in Section 2.1 of Exhibit 9). Specifically, what is Hydro proposing?
4 Please provide details of Hydro's expectations of the parties to this GRA with regard
5 to treatment of NP's curtailable load.

8 A. Hydro is proposing that the parties consider the issues related to the treatment for
9 NP's curtailable load, such as:

- 10 • the value of this load to the system given the constraints around the load;
- 11 • what risk, if any, should be borne by whom should the load not be available
12 between test years;
- 13 • whether and how NP should be compensated for new curtailable load
14 between test years;
- 15 • whether or how customers should be compensated if the curtailable load is
16 not available; and
- 17 • historic availability of the curtailable load when called upon.

18 Hydro suggests this consideration may be appropriate during the negotiation phase
19 of this process, when the parties will have the opportunity to express their opinions
20 on these and other matters related to the curtailable load.
