2 The 2014 forecast Holyrood fuel price is approximately \$11 million lower than the  
3 2013 Test Year forecast. Does Hydro believe it would be reasonable to adjust the  
4 2013 Test Year forecast and use the forecast Holyrood fuel price for 2014 to better  
5 reflect the cost of providing service for the period that customer rates will be in  
6 effect? If not, why not?
