Re: An Application by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro pursuant to Subsection 41(3) of the Act for approval of a capital expenditure to supplement the Allowance for Unforeseen Items for the construction and purchase of certain improvements and additions to its property

This is further to Ms. Blundon's email of 15 October, 2013 further to Hydro's filings its October 10, 2013 correspondence and attached report, "Black Tickle Diesel Plant Fire Restoration Project Unforeseen Capital Expenditures October 2013".

In its correspondence, Hydro notes that it is revising the amount applied for in its application of September 9, 2013 to \$353,955. In its application, Hydro requested that the Board approve a supplementary allowance of \$400,000 to permit Hydro to address unforeseen events that may arise during the remainder of 2013.
