Re: Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro – Application for Approval of Expenditures for the Installation of Diesel Units at Holyrood for the Purposes of Black Starting the Generating Units, and for the Deferral of Lease Costs (“Black start”) and Application to Supply and Install 100 MW(Nominal) of Combustion Turbine Generation – Combined Process and New Schedule of Dates

On March 11, 2014 the Board advised the parties that the remaining schedule for this application would be deferred to a later date.

The Board has decided that the issue of cost and cost recovery relating to the Black start capital project and the capital project to Supply and Install 100 MW (Nominal) of Combustion Turbine Generation ("100MW Gas Turbine application") will be addressed in a joint process. The parties therefore will be afforded the opportunity to issue further requests for information, file evidence and make submissions in the one proceeding.


On May 21, 2014 the Board set the schedule for the 100MW Gas Turbine application. Requests for Information ("RFIs") are to be filed on June 2, 2014 and responses to the RFIs required on June 16, 2014. The filing dates for any further RFI's relating to the Black start application will also be June 2, 2014.

In order to simplify the record the Board has decided to merge the previous RFIs filed in the Black start application with this file. To distinguish between the two sets of RFIs, RFIs relating to the Black start application will continue to be labelled in the same sequence and RFIs relating the 100MW Gas Turbine application should begin with the prefix GT.

Therefore the next RFIs relating to Black start application will continue sequentially as CA-NLH-20; IC-NLH-16; PUB NLH-8; and, NP-NLH-24. The Board's first RFI relating to the 100MW Gas Turbine application shall be labelled as GT-PUB-NLH-1.
