IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro, pursuant to Subsections 41(3) of the Act, for approval of refurbishment of the marine terminal at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station.

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION OF THE ISLAND INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS

IC – NLH – 1

With reference to “Section 4 – Install Evacuation Life Raft and Two Fixed Platforms to Allow Vessel Access” of Hydro’s report on the Refurbishment of the Marine Terminal at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station (page 31 thereof), Hydro relates that the provision of the secondary egress, as outlined at page 23 of the Hatch report, is essential.

- (a) To the date hereof have there been any instance in which an evacuation has been required but egress via the shore arm link has been prohibited? If yes, please provide details;
- (b) Has there ever been a “man overboard” situation at or near that section of the jetty?;
- (c) Please provide copies of any incident reports filed by Hydro employees, within the past five (5) years, with respect to life safety issues at the Marine Terminal;
- (d) Please provide a detailed breakdown of the costs associated with the installation of an evacuation life raft and two (2) fixed platforms at the Marine Terminal; and
- (e) Please provide a detailed breakdown of all life safety components of this project, including the costs of each such life safety component.

IC – NLH – 2

With reference to “Section 5 – Lighting Upgrades” of Hydro’s report on the Refurbishment of the Marine Terminal at the Holyrood

Thermal Generating Station (page 31 thereof), Hydro states that the estimated cost of this project to be \$115,000.00. In the Hatch report, cost estimates for jetty upgrades note lighting upgrades to have an estimated cost of \$65,000.00. Please explain why that component of the project is now an estimated \$50,000.00 more expensive than initially estimated?
