Assuming the Board does not approve the Interim Rate Application as proposed by Hydro and there are no changes to base rates or to the Rate Stabilization Plan methodology, what is the estimated impact on the July 1, 2015 Rate Stabilization Plan adjustment to Newfoundland Power Inc. rates and the average rates charged to Newfoundland Power Inc. customers? Provide supporting information regarding the forecast price per barrel of No. 6 fuel, the calculation of the current balance at March 31, 2015 in the NP Rate Stabilization Plan, the Adjustment and Financing included for April, May and June 2015, and the calculation of the Fuel Rider. As the March month end forecast may not be available the February 2015 month end forecast may be used for purposes of the calculation.

Assuming that the Board approves, effective July 1, 2015, a 10% base rate increase for Island Industrial customers on an interim basis, and the use of only the RSP Surplus to partially offset this increase for an effective rate increase to Island Industrial customers of 2.7%, and assuming approval of no other changes what would be the impact on the IC RSP Surplus?

Assuming that the Board approves, effective July 1, 2015, a 5% increase in the base rate to Newfoundland Power Inc., on an interim basis, the continuation of the currently approved Rate Stabilization Plan and cost of service methodology, and assuming approval of no other proposed changes, what would be the estimated overall rate impact for Newfoundland Power Inc. and for its customers at July 1, 2015? Show the impact on the base rate and the Rate Stabilization Plan adjustment, providing supporting information regarding the forecast price per barrel of No. 6 fuel, the calculation of the current balance at March 31, 2015 in the NP Rate Stabilization Plan, the Adjustment and Financing included for April, May and June 2015, and the calculation of the Fuel Rider. Explain any assumptions made to complete this exercise. As the March month end forecast may not be available the February 2015 month end forecast may be used for purposes of the calculation. Provide the same information for a 3%, an 8% and an 11.2% increase in the base rate to Newfoundland Power Inc.

Assume that the Board approves, effective July 1, 2015, an interim base rate increase which is 50% of the rates that Hydro proposes and continuation of currently approved Rate Stabilization Plan and cost of service methodology, with no other changes, provide the estimated impact on Hydro's 2015 revenue requirement and rate of return.

In a chart provide the actual monthly load for 2014 for each of the Industrial Customers and the most recent monthly load forecast for 2015 and for 2016 for each of the Industrial Customers, showing the percentage each is of the total annual figure.
