

1     Q.    Which provisions of the Rate Stabilization Plan rules provide the authority to make  
2           the January 1, 2014 Rate Stabilization Plan Adjustment for Newfoundland Power  
3           proposed in the Interim Rates Application?

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6     A.    Section D 1 of the RSP rules state that:

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8           *When new Test Year base rates come into effect, if a fuel rider forecast (either  
9           March or September) is more current than the test year fuel forecast, a fuel rider  
10          will be implemented at the same time as the change in base rates reflecting the  
11          more current fuel forecast and the new test year values.*

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13          Given that a September fuel rider forecast has been calculated and is more current  
14          than the Test Year fuel forecast, Hydro's Interim Rate Application requests approval  
15          for a change in the fuel price projection for Newfoundland Power effective January  
16          1, 2014 in accordance with the RSP rules.
