

1 Q. Further to the responses to IR-CA-NLH-004 and IR-PUB-NLH-001, provide the rates
2 for Domestic and General Service customers on the Island and Labrador Isolated
3 Systems that are proposed by Hydro to be implemented as part of its Interim Rates
4 Application.

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7 A. Rates for Domestic and General Service customers on the Island and Labrador
8 Isolated Systems cannot be determined until NP completes its rate design. Hydro's
9 Domestic Basic Customer Charge and Lifeline Block energy rate will be equal to the
10 rates NP designs for its domestic customers, with other Domestic rates and the
11 General Service customer rates depending upon the percentage rate change NP
12 designs for its similar rate classes. Hydro uses an estimated impact on end
13 consumers to forecast its rural revenue, but NP's detailed rate design may result in
14 different percentages.
