

1 Q. Reference: Interim Rate Application filed November 18, 2013, Rate Schedule A,
2 page 6 of 11.
3 Assuming that the Board accepts Vale's interpretation of Order in Council OC 2013-
4 89, that the phase in of rates is to occur over "a three year period ", and orders that
5 the phase in should end on August 31, 2016, please provide the interim rates that
6 Hydro would be seeking if the RSP Surplus is to be used to phase in rates until
7 August 31, 2016.

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10 A. If the Board accepts Vale's interpretation of OC2013-89 and rates are phased-in
11 until August 31, 2016 as opposed to August 31, 2015, Hydro would continue to seek
12 the same interim rates effective September 1, 2013 as outlined in this GRA for
13 Industrial Customers excluding Teck. However, the RSP Adjustment rate for Teck
14 effective September 1, 2013 would be revised from (1.111) cents/kWh to (1.356)
15 cents/kWh, the calculation of which is provided in the response to IR-V-NLH-023,
16 Attachment 2.
