

1     Q.     Please confirm that if the Board eliminated the RSP Load Variation provision  
2           starting January 1, 2014, the industrial customers would be owed approximately  
3           \$8.2 million from the Segregated Load Variation Provision that accrued prior to  
4           December 31, 2013.

7     A.     No.

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9           In Order No. P.U. 29(2013) the Board states as follows:

10          *“The parties agree that changes to way that the load variation is allocated in the*  
11          *RSP should be addressed in Hydro's general rate application and that Hydro should*  
12          *account separately for the load variation amounts beginning on September 1, 2013.*  
13          *The Board will therefore postpone consideration of these proposed changes to the*  
14          *RSP rules and will order that, beginning on September 1, 2013, the load variation*  
15          *amounts be segregated.”*

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17          The total amount (Industrial Customers and Utility) accrued in the segregated load  
18          variation provision as of December 31, 2013 was \$8,200,495. The amount of the  
19          segregated RSP Load Variation balance to be allocated to the Industrial Customers  
20          will be determined based upon the allocation method to be approved by the Board  
21          in dealing with the current GRA.
