1 Q. Please identify the employees and their positions who were involved in the search
2 and identification of the CT, including who went to investigate the package and
3 when this investigation took place.

A.

Hydro had been investigating available combustion turbine opportunities in the market place since 2012. In April 2014, Hydro issued a public tender for a 100MW (nominal) combustion turbine to be executed as an EPC (Turnkey) Contract. After receipt of bids and prior to award of the contract, an independent engineering firm was engaged by Hydro to inspect the stored condition of the unit ultimately purchased. This inspection took place between April 28 and May 1, 2014. Refer to Hydro's response to GT-DD-NLH-002 in its Application, *Supply & Install of 100MW Combustion Turbine Generator* for a copy of the inspection report. During the week of April 28, 2014, Hydro representatives (a General Manager from Regulated Operations and other Project Execution and Technical Services engineers) also visited the unit in the storage location to confirm condition. They also toured the ProEnergy Facilities. Names of individuals are not required for the Board or the Intervenors to gain an understanding of the matter before the Board, and it would be inappropriate to file personal identifying information.
