Q. Black Start: With the completion of the new Holyrood CT, black start was to be 1 2 provided by that new unit and the 8 leased diesels returned. Please describe the 3 physical work associated with this transition. When will this transition (or did this transition) take place? Please explain the reasons for any delays experienced in 5 making the transition. 6 7 8 A. The Holyrood CT is currently connected to the Holyrood Terminal Station, which is 9 the primary means of feeding the station service bus at the Holyrood Thermal Plant. 10 A redundant connection between the CT switchgear and the Holyrood Thermal Plant will also be established after the eight leased diesels are removed. The 11 existing distribution line infrastructure currently connecting the diesels to the 12 Holyrood Thermal Plant will be re-used for this redundant connection between the 13 14 CT and the Holyrood Thermal Plant. Switchgear and conduits have already been 15 installed as part of the CT project in preparation for making this connection once 16 the diesels are removed. 17 The transfer of blackstart capabilities to the Holyrood CT will be completed in the 18 19 second quarter of 2015, when the system load conditions allow for a test whereby 20 the load could be turned off to the Holyrood Thermal Plant and the new CT used to 21 blackstart the plant.
