1	Q.	New Combustion Turbine: in 2013, the industrial Customers suggested that Hydro
2		consider acceleration of the then-planned 50-60 MW CT in order to supply black
3		start capability at Holyrood. Did Hydro consider this option and, if so, please
4		provide any analyses performed?
5		
6		
7	A.	Hydro's notes that the above comment from the Industrial Customers was made by
8		submission dated November 28 2013, following Hydro's application Approval of the
9		Installation of Diesel Units at Holyrood for the Purpose of Black Starting the
10		Generating Unit and for the Deferral of Lease Costs (the "Blackstart Application"),
11		filed on November 22, 2013.
12		
13		The then-planned 50 to 60 MW CT would not have been in service for the winter of
14		2013/2014 and possibly not in service for the winter of 2014/2015. As noted in
15		Hydro's submission in the Blackstart Application, on Pages 3 to 4:

17 18 19 20 21 22 23		After considering several options, Hydro has determined that a short-term solution for the blackstart of Holyrood, which requires the installation of infrastructure to enable eight 1.825 MW diesel generation units to be leased during the winter months of 2014 to the time of installation of the new 60 MW combustion turbine. The installation date depends upon receipt of Board approval of this project.
24		Further, analyses were provided to the Board as noted in Attachment 5 to IC-NLH-
25		010 in the Blackstart Application, attached as Attachment 1 to Hydro's response to
26		PR-PUB-NLH-003.
