Please explain why the cost (\$160,900) to repair Sunnyside B1LO3 stated in the 1 2 response to PR-PUB-NLH-30 was included with the "Sunnyside Replacement Equipment" application approved by Order No. P.U. 29(2014) when this cost was 3 also included in the application for "Overhaul of the Sunnyside B1L03 230kV Breaker 4 and Overhaul of the Holyrood B1L17 230kV Breaker" approved by Order No. P.U. 5 6 23(2014). 7 8 9 PR-PUB-NLH-030 requested estimated versus actual costs for specific items related A. 10 to the Sunnyside Replacement Equipment project, approved by Order No. P.U. 11 29(2014), which included item (c), "the repair of the B1L03 230kV breaker at Sunnyside". The repair of the B1L03 breaker was not part of the Sunnyside 12 13 Replacement Equipment project, but was in fact part of the Overhaul of the 14 Sunnyside B1L03 230 kV Breaker and Overhaul of the Holyrood B1L17 230 kV 15 Breaker project, approved by Order No. P.U. 23(2014) and therefore has not been 16 applied for by Hydro in two separate applications.
