**NEWFOUNDLAND POWER INC.
2013 CAPITAL BUDGET APPLICATION**

TAKE NOTICE that on June 28, 2012 the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the “Board”) received an application (the “Application”) from Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) requesting an Order of the Board pursuant to Sections 41 and 78 of the *Public Utilities Act* (the “Act”):

- i) approving its 2013 Capital Budget in the amount of \$80,788,000;
- ii) approving capital expenditures in 2014 in the amount of \$3,853,000 related to multi-year projects commencing in 2013; and
- iii) fixing and determining its average rate base for 2011 in the amount of \$876,356,000.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that all customers of Newfoundland Power as well as customers of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro whose rates are based on Newfoundland Power rates may be affected by the outcome of the Application.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that anyone interested in participating in this Application must submit a Notice of Intention to Participate to the Board **before 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 18, 2012**. The Notice can be in the form of a letter and should clearly state the intended participant’s interests, concerns and contact information, including address and telephone number. Further communication as to the application process and timing will be made directly with participants.
