- A. Newfoundland Power does not currently have plans to decommission any of its power
 plants. The Company has not completed a detailed review of legislation that may be
 associated with the decommissioning or demolition of any of its power plants.
- 9 The Company is aware that a project to decommission a power plant could potentially 10 require registration under the *Environmental Protection Act*, and further that registration 11 may lead to a requirement for environmental assessment of the project pursuant to the 12 *Environmental Assessment Regulations, 2003.*
- 14If Newfoundland Power, at a future time, were to consider decommissioning one of its15power plants, the process of evaluating such decommissioning would include: (i) initial16consultation with the provincial authorities to determine whether registration of an17undertaking under the *Environmental Protection Act* would be required; and (ii) a18detailed site-specific legislative review to determine what other legislative requirements19may apply to the decommissioning of the plant in question.
