- Q. [Production Life] Please state whether the Company believes it provides inferior maintenance for its generating facilities compared to other electric utilities that also operate the same type of generating facilities. If the response is affirmative, identify each and every maintenance practice that the Company employs that it believes is inferior to other electric utility companies. Further, provide all support and justification for such practice..
- A. The Company does not believe it provides inferior maintenance for its generating facilities. The level of availability of the Company's generating facilities for the past 10 years, as shown in response to Request for Information CA-NP-021, would not suggest the Company provides inferior maintenance.
- Newfoundland Power's fleet of generating facilities is comprised of a mixture of legacy hydroelectric, older thermal and mobile generation which is atypical for the Canadian electric utility industry. This makes it difficult to draw comparisons with other Canadian utilities from a system perspective. The Company has not completed a study of the detailed maintenance practices of other electric utilities that also operate the same type of generating facilities, and so has no basis for a direct comparison of individual maintenance practices as requested.
