- Q. How have been the base salary increases for Newfoundland Power's Engineering, Professional and Managerial Employee Salary increases from 2000 to 2012 and how have the increases compared with the annual inflation rate?
- A. Table 1 provides Newfoundland Power's Engineering, Professional and Managerial employees' average base salary increase expressed as a percentage for the period 2000 to 2014F compared to the annual inflation rate for Newfoundland.<sup>1</sup>
