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The increase in costs for the Electricity Supply, Administrative and Engineering Support function from 2010 is mainly related to labour costs. This primarily reflects normal wage increases and the reassignment of personnel previously charged to other functions. The increase in other costs from 2010 primarily reflects increased employee relocation costs and computing equipment and software costs.

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
