- Q. [Account 363] In response to CA-NP-072, the Company identified retirements by type of street light. Please provide the reason for the 2001 retirement of 1,516 high-pressure sodium vapor lamps in the amount of \$616,000.
- A. Newfoundland Power commenced installing high-pressure sodium ("HPS") street lights in 1982. The number and cost of HPS street lights retired in 2001 is consistent with retirements in 2003 and 2004, and reflect Newfoundland Power's experience that street lights tend to have an average service life of approximately 20 years.
