## 1Q.[Account 342] – Please identify the number and corresponding dollar value of2transformers that contain PCB levels that require removal in the near future.3

- A. The federal *PCB Regulations* that came into force in September 2008 require that, by
  December 31, 2014, PCB levels in oil-filled electrical equipment, other than pole-top
  transformers and light ballasts, must be lower than 500 milligrams per kilogram. This
  requirement applies to the power transformers in Account 342.
- 9 To ensure compliance with the 2008 regulatory amendment, Newfoundland Power began 10 compliance testing of its oil-filled equipment in 2010. Where necessary, the oil is 11 replaced or non-compliant equipment is removed from service.
- None of the power transformers in Account 342 will be removed from service as a result
  of this compliance process. The oil in all of the power transformers in Account 342
  meets the requirements of the legislation. However, testing of the oil-filled bushings of
  these transformers is ongoing, and will result in the replacement of any non-compliant
  bushings.
