

1 **Q. Further to Ms. McShane’s reply to CA-NP-292, does Ms. McShane have a**
2 **subscription from SNL Financial which would allow her access to RRA rate case**
3 **final reports for each of the latest cases involving utilities in her sample in this**
4 **proceeding? Can these documents be provided by way of a posting to**
5 **Newfoundland Power’s stranded website?**

7 A. Ms. McShane has access to RRA rate case formal reports but (i) she has not relied upon
8 them in preparing her testimony and (ii) they are proprietary copyrighted content.
9

10 So, Ms. McShane and Newfoundland Power object to their production. Neither Ms.
11 McShane nor Newfoundland Power are obliged to provide research services for the
12 Consumer Advocate.

14 Rate case decisions and/or orders are, however, typically publically available at no cost
15 on the websites of the respective local regulators.
