ELG] - Regarding the references to prior Board approval of the ELG methodology, 2 please provide the testimony or report submitted to the Board in each case 3 regarding requests for the implementation or continuation of ELG depreciation, as 4 well as any contrary evidence submitted in each of those proceedings. To the extent 5 any of the requested information is not in the possession of the Company, state 6 whether the Company is aware that any opposing position was presented to the 7 Board regarding acceptance of the ELG procedure and what that opposing position 8 was, in the greatest level of detail available, and the basis for such statement. 9
- 10 A. The response to Request for Information CA-NP-017 provides copies of all depreciation studies provided by Newfoundland Power to the Board from 1977 through 2005. The 2010 Depreciation Study was filed in *Volume 3, Expert Evidence and Studies*.
- These are the materials submitted to the Board since 1977 justifying the implementation or continuation of the Company's use of the Equal Life Group ("ELG") procedure.
- Newfoundland Power does not have copies of the contrary evidence submitted in each proceeding which considered the Company's implementation or continuation of the ELG procedure. For a summary of other, including opposing, positions, the Company recommends that the Consumer Advocate review the relevant Board orders.
