- Q. [ELG] Regarding the statement at the bottom of page 15 of Mr. Wiedmayer's rebuttal testimony that making dramatic, major, or significant changes requires overwhelming evidence, please provide how often Gannett Fleming previously proposed dramatic, major, or significant changes in life or net salvage parameters in other proceedings.
- A. Gannett Fleming does not maintain a list of every instance in which it makes significant changes to life or net salvage parameters. However, as indicated in the response to Request for Information CA-NP-627, such a change normally would be accompanied by significant evidence to support both the estimate made and the reason why a more gradual change is not more appropriate. The evidence could be found either in the historical data or in information external to the data, or possibly in both.
