2 **rebuttal testimony that he used a combination of mathematical and visual curve**
3 **matching to fit Iowa Survivor curves, please state whether ultimate or predominate**
4 **reliance on mathematical curve-fitting is a standard practice of Gannett Fleming, or**
5 **is the predominant practice of Gannett Fleming the reliance on visual curve-fitting.**
6 **To the extent any significant level of reliance is claimed for mathematical curve-**
7 **fitting, provide all support and justification for such position as it applies to Gannett**
8 **Fleming’s depreciation testimony in other jurisdictions.**

10 A. Gannett Fleming’s survivor curve estimates are based on informed judgment that
11 considers both mathematical and visual curve matching. It does not place predominant
12 reliance on mathematical curve matching.
