1 Q. Please outline the basis for the payment of .20/kW per hour.

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A. The variable payment reflects the risk assumed by CBPP for each shut down as well as the implications associated with reductions or breaks in operations as a result of providing capacity assistance. These payments provide Hydro with coincidental fuel savings as Hydro will be requesting that capacity assistance be implemented prior to starting its last operational combustion turbine. Therefore, Hydro will be

turbine. The \$0.20/kW per hour reflects approximately one-half of the cost per kWh

avoiding fuel costs which would otherwise be incurred by running its combustion

of Hydro operating its highest cost standby unit.
