1	Q.	Has Hydro discussed with Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited the possibility of
2		entering into a contract for one year (2014/2015) for the provision of capacity
3		assistance in blocks of 20, 40 or 60 MW? Provide the results of such discussions,
4		describe the obstacles to entering into such an agreement, and provide the
5		economic analysis that resulted from this proposal, if it occurred.

8	A.	The proposed agreement with Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited (CBPP)
9		commences as of December 1, 2014 and expires on March 31, 2018. However,
10		either party may unilaterally terminate this agreement by providing advance
11		written notice to the other party (the terms of which are set forth in the
12		agreement). Therefore both Hydro and CBPP have the option to terminate the
13		agreement after the 2014/2015 winter season.
