Q. If Hydro has determined the appropriate level of capacity assistance required, how does the proposed agreement with Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited affect the level of capacity assistance that might be required from Vale Newfoundland and Labrador Limited?

Please see PUB-NLH-010. The emergency capacity represents a small portion of Hydro's total Island Interconnected capacity. Hydro's investigations determined that a total of approximately 76 MW of emergency capacity could be made available from two of its Island Industrial Customers and that this capacity was available at low cost. Based upon the low cost of the capacity, and the high usefulness and value to Hydro's customers that this emergency capacity could provide in the unlikely event that Hydro experienced capacity availability issues as it did in January of 2014, it was determined that Hydro should secure this readily available capacity.
