Q.	Do you have all the approvals for the installation of the new fuel tank to supply the
	Greenhill Gas Turbine?

A. Newfoundland Power is required to seek approval for the installation of the new fuel tank to supply the Greenhill Gas Turbine under the *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulations*, 2003 under the authority of Section 111 of the *Environmental Protection Act*.

 The Company is in the process of preparing the required documentation to seek the necessary approval. Included with the required documentation are engineering drawings for the specific storage tank for which approval is being sought. This will require a supply contract to be put into place with a qualified manufacturer, which cannot occur without prior approval of the Board. Timelines around the application and approval process are such that the Company does not anticipate any difficulty receiving the necessary government approval in advance of the installation of the new fuel tank.
