
**Re: Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro - March 4, 2015 Voltage Collapse -
Clarification of Fuel Valve Setting**

This is further to the Board's letter of November 20, 2015. Hydro has not determined how the fuel valve came out of proper adjustment and has no new information to provide on the March 4, 2015 event beyond that which Hydro has already reported on March 23, 2015, as cited in the aforementioned letter of the Board. Hydro confirms that there are no log entries or other accounts of the event that indicate how the valve setting was adjusted.

Upon his review of the November 5, 2015 transcript, Mr. MacIsaac has indicated that notwithstanding his testimony on the matter, he had intended to provide an explanation as to how valve adjustments typically occur in the operation of combustion turbines and similar generating equipment, as opposed to a specific finding as to this event. Mr. MacIsaac has no further or different information from what was formerly reported as to this incident. Hydro sincerely apologizes for any inconvenience or misunderstandings this may have caused.
