8		maintenance activities were performed on these breakers:

10		October 2012: Breaker overhaul performed on-site by a Schneider
11		Electric technician during the annual overhaul;
12		December 2012: Breaker 52SST2 was sent to Schneider for a complete
13		overhaul. Insufficient components were available to perform a complete
14		overhaul; and
15		January 2013: Breaker NESB3 is not working. The breaker opened
16		automatically when closed.
