11	A.	Section 3 of the <i>Electrical Power Control Act, 1994</i> , states, among other things, that:

14		3. It is declared to be the policy of the province that
15		(b) all sources and facilities for the production, transmission and distribution
16		of power in the province should be managed and operated in a manner
17		(iii) that would result in power being delivered to consumers in the
18		province at the lowest possible cost consistent with reliable service,

20		In determining whether or not each component of the current Island hydraulic
21		plant will continue to be an essential component of the Provincial electrical grid,
22		after full commissioning of the Post-Isolated Island System, any factors that Hydro
23		will take into consideration, in supplying power within the Province to Island
24		customers, will be in accordance with the power policy of the Province set out in
25		the Electrical Power Control Act, 1994.
