7	A.	The 20 year service life estimate, indicated on Replace Accommodations and Septic
8		System, Volume II, Tab 20, Page 7, is incorrect.
9		
10		Hydro considers the depreciable life of a building, constructed from anything other
11		than steel, to be 50 years. With that said, it is reasonable to assume that the life
12		expectancy of a facility which is unoccupied for a substantial portion of its service
13		life will be reduced when compared to that of a permanently occupied facility. The
14		service life of an accommodations camp is estimated to be 35 years.
